



## **Volunteer Opportunities – Pathways’ Donation Center**

*Below is a list of volunteer opportunities with Pathways’ storage and donation program. Our clients help in these areas when their schedules allow, but they have more important case goals that we want them to prioritize. - I. Storage Unit**
  - a. Donation Receivers/Organizers**
    - i. Place donated items where they belong in storage. We have two and four-wheel carts to assist with moving the larger items.
  - b. Donation Cleaners**
    - i. Some donations may need some “touching up”, such as dusting or wiping down with a cleaner.
  - c. Donation Repairers**
    - i. Some items we receive could be usable with some “TLC”. Perhaps there are some screws missing, or some minor repairs that could be made to make the items usable again. We would rather re-purpose than take it to the dump!
- II. Donation/Furniture Moving**
  - a. Donation Pickup**
    - i. Pathways has a cube truck that we use to pick up furniture and move clients. Pathways’ staff member Beth will always be able to drive the truck, but there will be times she will need assistance picking up larger loads of furniture, or larger furniture items.
  - b. Moving Assistance**
    - i. When Pathways’ clients find stable housing, they pick out items from storage to fill their new home. The items are loaded onto Pathways’ truck and are delivered to the clients’ home. Ideally, we would like to have three or four people to help with the process to make it easier on everyone involved (clients will always help if they are physically able and are not working during the time we are available to get them moved). Typically, a move takes no longer than an hour.
