



Volunteer Opportunities at Pathways – Main Building

Below is a list of volunteer opportunities with Pathways' main facility. Pathways' clients all have chores they are required to complete around our facility, and also assist with these items when their schedules allow. However, they have other goals we need them to prioritize. We would like to have a database of names and numbers to call when opportunities arise. - I. Room Cleaning**
 - a. When clients move out of a room, we have a cleaning checklist to follow in order to prepare the room for the next tenant. Vacuuming, sanitizing, replacing bedding, etc. A room cleaning generally lasts one hour.
- II. Room Repairs**
 - a. There are times that small repairs are needed in rooms that we can perform without having to call in a professional. Examples are repairing trim, painting, damaged sheetrock, replacing sink or toilet supply lines, etc.
- III. Transportation**
 - a. Pathways' clients often need transportation to and from work, medical appointments, or other necessary meetings throughout during the week (and weekends). Pathways' staff members typically transport using Pathways' van. However, it would save staff time if we had some volunteers who might be willing to drive our van. A volunteer would need a valid SD Driver's License and a relatively clean driving record.
- IV. Volunteer Advocate**
 - a. Pathways is a very busy place most days. The phone rings often, donations come in, and clients have needs or requests throughout the day. We have several wonderful people who donate their time to volunteer behind our front desk answering calls and helping clients with various needs. We are looking for individuals (or couples) who might be interested in this opportunity on a weekly or monthly basis.
- V. Laundry**
 - a. We go through a lot of bedding and towels when clients come and go. We have two dedicated washers and dryers in our basement for laundering these items. Sometimes it is more than staff can keep up with. We are looking for volunteers to assist with this process, either by laundering the items in our basement or taking them home if desired.
